EDU RAND Ranking

The EDU RAND 2015 rankings, now two years in the running, are based on objective measurements of four components of quality – employability, research productivity, faculty qualifications and fill rates. The former two, (employability and research productivity) are measures of outcomes. Faculty qualifications are measures of the quality of a key input to the learning experience, while fill rates take in account the students’ demand for education at the institution. All four components are scored on a scale of zero to ten, with ten amounting to the best performance on each outcome and zero the worst. The ever-increasing demand for highly specialized skills has led to a spurt in the setting up of engineering colleges across the country. In order to pick the right educational institution, Pick A College has been developed to enable prospective engineering students to access a platform wherein an accurate assessment of colleges in India is presented.
