Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Technology (MGIT) founded by Chaitanya Bharathi Educational Society (CBES) in 1997 has grown rapidly since its inception, on a serene and tranquil landscape at Gandipet, Hyderabad. The institute is affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University (JNTUH), Hyderabad and has the distinction of being awarded accreditation by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) in 2009 & 2014. The lush green campus of MGIT spread over 30 acres of pleasant landscape with a constructed area of 28773 sqm. The institute is having 1026 computer systems spread across various departments, with latest configuration and connected through LAN. 70 MBPS Internet facility is available for all departments and Library. The CBES was established in 1979 by a group of eminent personalities. The primary objective of this educational society is to create temples of knowledge so as to impart value-based education to

country.

The Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Technology (MGIT) offers eight UG courses and six PG courses from the Academic Year 2014-15.

Initially MGIT started functioning with three branches with an intake of 160. At present, the intake is 1008 (UG: 900, PG: 108) and the total strength of students is 3,216.

The institution has 189 well qualified and dedicated faculty members, which includes professors, associate professors, of whom 41 are doctorates and another 69 registered for doctoral degrees. It has 165 experienced and committed technical and supporting staff.

Training and Placement Cell

The college offers special training to enhance the employability of its students. TCS, Deloitte, CSC, Infosys, Wipro, SAB-Miller, Franklin-Templeton, HSBC, Oracle, ADP, Amazon, IBM, Hyderabad

conducts on-campus placements. MGIT was accredited by TCS for campus placements. Campus placements provided for 75% eligible candidates during the last three years
